- A willingness to contribute to RBA Development initiatives and underpinning programmes (workshops, clinics)
- Actively pursuing other opportunities for professional development
- A member in good standing of their respective Club/School

Coaches must possess the following basketball attributes:

- Completed or working towards Community Coach Accreditation
- Sound knowledge of technical and tactical aspects of basketball
- Familiarity with the talent pool in RBA would be advantageous
- Actively coaching within Association/club/school programmes

Managers must possess the following attributes:

- Familiarity with RBA, and basketball environments
- Sound administration and budgetary skills adhering to all RBA policies and procedures
- Excellent organization and interpersonal skills as well as creative thinking skills
- Ability to handle multiple tasks simultaneously and prioritises appropriately in a fast-paced environment
- Ability to work in conjunction with coaching staff and the RBA office to satisfactorily execute programme requirements
- Managers are also expected to be able to transport, therefore, must have a current “Full” driver’s license.
